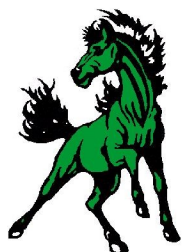

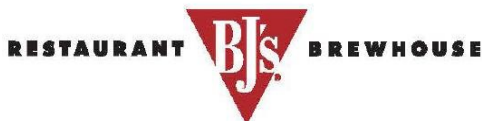

Seniors: The College Go Center (located in Room B119) will be meeting with your student to help them complete the FAFSA. FAFSA is Federal Student Aid. What is federal student aid? It's money from the federal government that helps you pay for college, career school, or graduate school expenses. Federal student aid is available through grants, work-study funds, and loans. Grants are not required to be paid back, that is FREE money to use towards your education. By completing the FAFSA, you will see how much money might be available to you!
